

THE SIR TOM FINNEY FOOTBALL CLUB PLAYER REGISTRATION POLICY

Introduction

This policy sets out the rules relating to player registration for all teams at The Sir Tom Finney FC. This includes:

Disability adult registrations	Adult Secretary and Registrations
Disability youth registrations	U7-U10 and Girls Registrations Secretary

Youth (Mixed and Girls) Registrations

The STFFC operate maximum squad sizes depending on the playing format:

Format	Maximum Squad Size	
5 a side	8	
7 a side	10	
9 a side	14	
11 a side	16	

Any requests for exceptions must be brought to the club committee for consideration.

Player recruitment for teams from U7 up to U12 must follow the following process.

- Any player wishing to join The Sir Tom Finney FC must be directed to the Sir Tom Finney Soccer Centre. Players who regularly attend the soccer centre will take primacy at being signed prior to any other consideration.
- Any request to fill a vacancy from elsewhere must be approved by the Committee.

Player recruitment for teams from U13 up to U18 must follow the following process.

- Players who regularly attend the soccer centre will take primacy at being signed prior to any other consideration.
- Any requirement to fill a vacancy from elsewhere is at the discretion of the Team Manager.

The STFFC will not "poach" players from other clubs and any such action will be referred to the committee for consideration of appropriate action.

Registrations for all youth players must be completed using the appropriate google form. This form will include confirmation of:

- Contact Details
- Medical Information
- Photo Consent
- STFFC Introduction Letter and FAQ's
- FA Respect codes of conduct for Young Players
- FA Respect code of conduct Spectators and Parents
- Monthly subscriptions and kit ownership
- TSTFFC Privacy Policy "STFFC-Privacy-Notice-July-2024"
- Commitment to attend training and matches.

Adult Registrations

Players are required to complete the "Adult Player Registration Form 2024 25 Season" form and abide by the FA Respect code of conduct for Adult Players.

Disability Registrations

Disability football is largely governed by The Sir Tom Finney Soccer Centre but players are required to register with TSTFFC for matches.
